

**Keithsburg City Council Minutes**  
**Held at 302 S. 14<sup>th</sup> Street**  
**June 13, 2011**

**Mayor Askew Opened the Meeting at 6:30 PM**

**Alderman Physically Present:** Roy Pritchett, Maxine Henry, Davina Logsdon, Jeff Gilmour, George Askew and Neil Nylin.

**Minutes of last month meeting:** Neil made a motion to accept; Davina seconded, accepted by all.

**Cash Receipts:** Davina made a motion to accept; Maxine seconded, accepted by all.

**Cash Disbursements:** Attached list plus pay out of General Fund Checking: Wagoner Brothers for 144 loads of sand @ \$5.00 per load for a total of \$720.00; Lee Tree Service for cutting down tree at 13<sup>th</sup> & Madison Street and to be paid out of the Campground Checking: Bancard for \$991.07 Reliable bill for campground supplies. Neil asked if Chief Robinson had permission to order supplies from Uniform Den (collar insignia, hard case and earphone). Chief Robinson must have approval from the council prior to spending, therefore Neil made a motion to accept the cash disbursements with the stipulation that the bill for Uniform Den in the amount of \$57.70 is to be deducted from Chief Robinson's check, George seconded, accepted by all.

**Keithsburg Police Department Manual:**

Neil made a motion to accept; Davina seconded, accepted by all.

**Semi-Parking Issue:** Arnold suggested the north side of the Ballpark. Maxine made a motion to table until next month, Roy seconded, accepted by all.

**Hiring Part-Time Police Officer:** This matter was discussed last month and Chief Robinson was going to talk with a few police officers and see if they would be interested in working part-time. Chief Robinson was not present. After much discussion Neil made a motion to advertise for part-time police officer, George seconded, accepted by all.

**Campground Directional Signs:** Maxine made a motion to spend up to \$300.00 for signs, Roy seconded, accepted by all.

**Prevailing Wage Ordinance:** Roy made a motion to accept; Maxine seconded, accepted by all.

**Police Department:** Chief Robinson was not present; however all of the council members had a copy of a benefit package proposal which would allow him free camping as an added bonus in exchange for being the Chief of Police. Roy explained he was given free camping last year because he did not live here and now he is a resident. Neil suggested not allowing the free camping and that Chief Robinson would no longer be dictating what hours he will work. In addition the council agreed that Chief Robinson will be taking orders from Neil who is the chairman of the police department. The council all agreed that we need a police officer on duty more throughout the weekends and not so much during the weekdays. George made motion to completely throw out the benefit package proposal including no free camping, Neil seconded, accepted by all.

**Campground:** Neil suggested pouring (10) new concrete pads. The council agreed to wait until fall and see how well the campground does this summer. Mayor Askew is going to meet with the engineers to see about dredging the bank in again. The council thanked George and Mark for all their hard work at the campground.

**Special Use Permit:** David and Terri Gibson applied for a special use permit to open a Bait Shop and Landscaping Business, plus sell pond supplies. Legal Description is Lots 1 & 2, in Block 4 in Sheriff & Cabeen's Addition, more commonly known as 704 Monroe Street. Maxine made a motion to accept; Davina seconded. Roy-yes; Davina-yes; Maxine-yes; Jeff-yes; George-yes and Neil-yes. Motion carried.

**Hilltop Bail Shop Revolving Loan Fund:** David and Terri Gibson applied for a \$5,000 loan to startup a bait shop. Davina made a motion to accept; Roy seconded, accepted by all.

Maxine made motion to adjourn, Roy seconded, accepted by all.
